- Communication skills
- Critical thinking and evaluation skills
- Search and information seeking
- Project management skills



Challenges of Research Projects

Research is a complex undertaking and an area where many undergraduates are still working to develop skills and proficiencies

- Threshold concept theory in information literacy instruction
- Developing research assignments that help students master difficult concepts and skills



Challenges of Research Projects in Online Environments

- · Access to materials, resources, and help



Structuring Research Assignments in Online Environments

- 1. Break down and scaffold your content
- 2. Introduce opportunities to practice skills
- 3. Introduce opportunities for reflection
- 4. Consider creative applications
- 5. Consider multiple deliverables
